





·A reflection activity where participants discuss how fabric reflects identity, resilience, and craftsmanship




Textile Stories & English Skills

Day 3 connects heritage and communication—exploring Ireland's textile history and building English skills through interactive workshops and fashion-themed activities.









Day 4 at the Botanic Gardens: exploring natural dyes, eco-fibres, and creativity through sketching and group reflection.









